



Bishop Gets The Wrong Day, North Marston, May 1873

“An unfortunate *contretemps* took place on Monday, May 12th, in this parish. A special confirmation had been appointed and there were nearly fifty candidates, but the Bishop of Oxford was not forthcoming, his lordship having mistaken the day. A large party awaited the Bishop’s arrival at the Vicarage. His lordship arrived the day after and has appointed the Sunday after Ascension Day for the confirmation”.
