



**Extracts from Buckinghamshire Local Occurrences, 1841-1880**

**5<sup>th</sup> March 1873:** *“An entranced girl is living at Turville; it is stated she has taken no food for two years.”*

**3<sup>rd</sup> June 1880:** *“A girl at Turville, near Henley, has been in a trance for nine years, taking no solid support; she is perfectly helpless and unconscious.”*

**March 1875:** *‘We have only just heard that the child who was killed last November in sliding down the banisters of some railway stairs at Kings Cross Station, was born of Northmarston parents.’*
