Bucks Herald 1884: NORTH MARSTON

“OUTBREAK OF FEVER...We regret to hear that a serious outbreak of fever has occurred at Schorne College, in this village, a considerable number of the inmates, mainly students, having been attacked and two deaths, one of a domestic servant and one of a student, having taken place. Happily the disease has thus far been confined to the College, and as a wise precaution the National Day Schools, which are situated in close proximity to Schorne, have been closed for the time. Good health prevails generally throughout the village proper.”
